**Purpose of Committee Meeting: Direction to be taken in regard to Wagin Camera Club Woolorama Interclub Competition exhibited annually at the Wagin Agricultural Show Photography Section.**

- WCC to keep own identity and abide by Woolorama & Club rules, which are attached with entry forms sent to clubs affiliated with WAPF. *Copy attached for reference.*
- WCC will not apply to WAPF for subsidy for judging of competition as it can be covered by entry fee received by the club at this point in time.
- WCC acknowledges that the WAPF Judges Association is an option when seeking judge/judges.
- WCC to pay entry fee in line with other clubs submitting entries.
- Hanging area to remain as in previous years. Inside Wall Panels, Back Wall Panels and the use of 2 upright stands; one side only which will face back wall.
- Number of prints to be reduced from 15 to 12 per club and max of 2 per member.
- No date/time restrictions on images entered.
- Mounts must be black or white. Maximum size including mount is 50cm x 40cm. Minimum image size: 20cm x 20cm square; 14cm x 25cm rectangular/panorama.
- Prints behind matt board mounts must have a protective backing board. Maximum thickness of the matte, print and backing is 5mm.
- Memento prize vouchers: Discussed at length. More professional, would limit some winners to claim. Fitzgerald Photo Lab to be approached for vouchers.
- Prize money to remain as recently increased. Winning Club receives the Perpetual trophy and \$75; 1<sup>st</sup> \$100; 2<sup>nd</sup> \$50; 3<sup>rd</sup> \$25

Outstanding correspondence from Colin White re judging of the 2019 Woolorama Interclub competition by Brent Acie, John Taylor, Ron Speed and Colin White, it was decided to pay each judge \$50.00 as a thank you for their time and support. Coral will deliver to each at the WAPF Event with Thankyou cards.
